

Towards the end of 1987, Board membership was expanded in anticipation of a broadening of the TRIUMF joint venture to include a more national representation of Canadian universities long associated with the TRIUMF experimental program. The University of Manitoba and Université de Montréal became associate members, and the University of Toronto joined as an observer. At the end of 1988, University of Toronto status changed from that of observer to associate member. In March, 1989 the University of Regina became an associate member.
