To enter into the TRIUMF Photo Walk, please read and sign the following forms. Email your signed copy to communications@triumf.ca. Only 12 photographers will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. You will receive confirmation of your participation in the event.

N.B. Only those photographers who submit a signed photo release and entry form will be eligible.

Photo Walk: October 18, 2014

Participants of the Photo Walk are asked to meet at the TRIUMF Lobby at 9:45 am to sign-in and meet their tour guides. The tour leaves the lobby at precisely 10 am and unfortunately, latecomers will be unable to join the event.

At 10:00 am, participants will be assigned to a tour guide (one tour guide for every 3-4 photographers) who will guide them around the site. There will be three main stops: Meson Hall, ISAC-I and ISAC-II. At each location, the tour guide will provide information about the research conducted at that area and answer any questions. Photographers will have about 45 minutes at each location to shoot and capture. After rotating through the three stations, the tour will be escorted back to the Lobby.

Participants are welcome to use the UBC paid parking lot located on site, as well as an area to securely lock up bicycles in front of the main office building. If taking public transit, the #41 bus stops in front of TRIUMF. More information: www.triumf.ca/home/contact-us/maps-triumf.

Photo Submissions: October 31, 2014

Participants will send a maximum of 20 high-resolution photos to TRIUMF either directly via email to communications@triumf.ca or send a link to the web tool hosted online, such as Flickr, which TRIUMF may access to download the digital photo in high-resolution. TRIUMF will contact each photographer whose photograph has been selected as a winner.

Please use the following naming convention: lastname_firstname_1, lastname_firstname_2, etc.

TRIUMF will base selection of photographs for the exhibit on the basis of creativity and the ability to capture the interplay between art and science, using technical aspects of photography to display the scientific world.

Prizes

Jury's Choice: First (\$100) Honourable Mentions (\$50) – A local group of experts will be invited to choose the best photos, in their professional opinion.

People's Choice: First (\$50) Honourable Mentions (\$25) – The longlist of photos will be uploaded to Flickr and social media. A snapshot of total 'likes' per photo will dictate the winners.

Scientist's Choice: First (\$50) Honourable Mentions (\$25) – TRIUMF researchers will vote for the photo that best represents "Research at Work: Accelerating Science for Canada."

Exhibition, Early 2015

Approximately nine photographs will be selected by the public, TRIUMF scientists, and a professional jury and be exhibited at Science World (www.scienceworld.ca) and showcased on the symmetry magazine website (www.symmetrymagazine.org). Additional photos may also be selected for semi-permanent display at TRIUMF. Photographers will be notified.

Terms and Conditions

Safety

At TRIUMF, your safety is a primary concern for us. We have outlined some important safety information every visitor must review before visiting.

Bags and Shoes

- Large bags/knapsacks are not permitted on-site. There is absolutely no food or drinks (including water) allowed on the tour. However, cameras are welcome. Small camera bags will be tolerated at the discretion of the tour guides.
- Flat, comfortable shoes are required for all tours. The tour route has stairs and walkways with industrial grating and, therefore heels are not allowed and skirts are not recommended.

Magnetic Fields

- Due to the magnetic fields present on the TRIUMF site, people with any implanted medical devices may be at risk as these can function erratically even in relatively weak magnetic fields. People with any type of electrically, magnetically, or mechanically activated implants should remain outside and away from magnetic fields. Before arriving at TRIUMF, any visitor with an implanted medical device should visit their doctor to get documentation that their device is magnetic certified.
- Implanted Medical Devices include, but are not limited to:
 - Pacemakers,
 - Neurostimulators
 - Infusion Pumps
 - Intracranial Aneurysm Clips
 - Shunts & Stents
 - Cochlear Implants
 - Implantable cardioverter defibrillators (ICDS)
- Large medical implants such as hip replacements will not be affected nor will credit cards or any consumer electronic equipment.

Radiation Safety

- Tour participants must stay together with the tour guide at all times for the duration of the tour.
- Persons having had a nuclear medicine scan within the last week must inform Kyla Shauer (communications@triumf.ca) prior to their arrival, as they are likely to set off the portal monitor when entering or leaving the site. A doctor's note is required, as entry will not be permitted to the site if the portal monitor sounds an alarm.

Terms and Conditions (con't)

General

- To be eligible to participate, photographers must be a resident of British Columbia.
- Participants must have reached the age of 18 by October 18th
- Participants must be able to travel to TRIUMF for the time allotted.
- TRIUMF reserves the right to refuse entry or remove anyone from the TRIUMF facility due to safety concerns or inappropriate behavior.

Entry

- To be eligible to participate in both the Photowalk and subsequent contest, the photo release form and entry form must be filled out and emailed to communications@triumf.ca.
- Photos may be used for non-commercial purposes at TRIUMF's discretion.

Contest

- All entries will be reviewed and the TRIUMF Communications team will create a Long List. All photos in the Long List will be eligible for prizes.
- The same photograph cannot win in more than one category.
- All winners and honourable mentions will receive a gift certificate to a local photography store and their photo exhibited at Science World.
- Participants will send a maximum of 20 high-resolution photos to TRIUMF. If more than 20 photos are received, the excess photos will not be eligible for entry into the contest.
- All photos must be in either JPEG or TIFF format.
- TRIUMF will contact each photographer whose photograph has been selected as a winner.
