## 2021 Particle Physics Experiment Evaluation Committee (PP-EEC) Meeting in April

Dear Experimenters,

We would like to inform you that TRIUMF has established a new Particle Physics Experiment Evaluation Committee (PP-EEC) for particle physics proposals related to the Electron Hall, Meson Hall and UCN beam line channels at TRIUMF. For consistency, what was the SAP-EEC has thus been renamed the Nuclear Physics Experiment Evaluation Committee (NP-EEC). Documentation on the TRIUMF web pages will be updated to reflect this in due course.

We are pleased to share with you that the new PP-EEC will be chaired by Natalie Roe (LBNL) and composed of the following committee members: Concettina Sfienti (Mainz), Deborah Harris (York/FNAL), Ralf Kaiser (Glasgow), Natalia Toro (SLAC), Makoto Fujiwara (TRIUMF) and David McKeen (TRIUMF) who will also be the committee's secretary.

We will hold the first meeting of the new PP-EEC in the second half of April 2021 (exact date to be announced). Submissions that will be accepted are:

1. **New Letters of Intent** for experiments for which a substantial extension of the facility capabilities is needed. These extensions include either development of certain beams with sufficient intensities and purities or developments of new facilities enabling new experimental capabilities, such as major new equipment for new techniques.
2. **New Proposals** for experiments that use well-established technologies and can use existing beamlines and no major new developments are needed.
3. **Progress Reports** for existing experiments (proponents will be contacted directly).

The main purpose of this first meeting is to evaluate new particle physics experiments either for Letters of Intent or Proposals and, if applicable, to allocate available shifts. It will also give the committee an opportunity to hear Progress Reports from existing experiments.

If you are planning on a submission, please email [sciencediv@triumf.ca](mailto:sciencediv@triumf.ca) for the appropriate forms and an experiment number. The email should include the names and email addresses of the spokespersons and the title of the experiment. The **deadline for submission** is Monday 29<sup>th</sup> of March at 11:59 PST to the same email address.
